- Renovation of canteen facility
- Renovation of kitchen, dining hall of the hostel along with furniture

For 100 computers, Peripherals along with Monitors were arranged by Sri.R.Mananathan. A special thanks is reserved for Sri.Srikanth, Vice President, Ford Motors India Ltd, who donated these computers and workstations to SIT.
- Construction of new paper technology laboratory with the state of art equipments donated by Seshasayee Papers and Boards Limited (Worth Rs.25 lakhs) for which SITAA donated Rs.25 lakhs
- As a mark of respect, constructed a grand auditorium with the busts of Sri.G.Sundaram and Sri.Ananthanarasimhachar, Former Principals named as GS-ANC Auditorium with seating area covered with roofing. (approximately Rs.85 lakhs)
- MOM signed with SIT – Endowments for awarding the students
- To the deserving students – Scholarship arrangement is made through GSANC Memorial fund with a fixed deposit of Rs.19 lakhs approx.
- Active, Healthy Alumni Association having 5200 life members
- National Board of Accreditation for four programs in SIT since 2024 to 2027 (Academic period). SITAA played a vital role during the evaluation by NBA assessment team in January 2024 as a stakeholder of the institution.
- Computerized Communication skill laboratory “Drona Hall” was renovated and inaugurated by Sri.R.Narayanan, 1969 Mech., at a cost of Rs.2.5 lakhs.

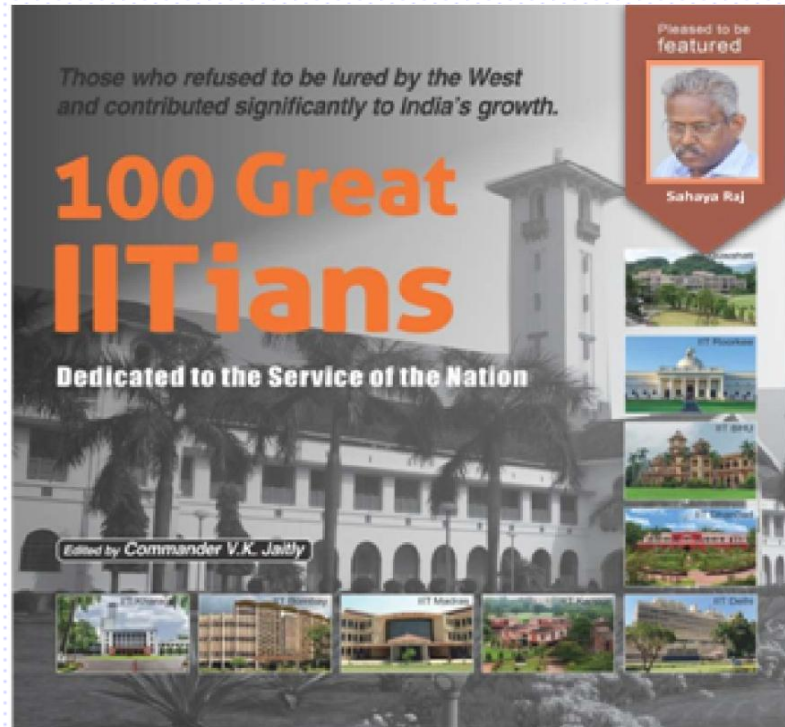

Sahaya Raj is not only a Great IITian, but also he is a Great SITian. **He passed out his Pre Technical Course in 1974 from SIT**, ranking fourth in Tamil Nadu State in the year 1974, which could help for his direct admissions into IIT Kharagpur, the first institute in India to offer the Naval Architecture course, Hails from Trichy in Tamil Nadu. Graduated in 1979 with a B.Tech (Hons.) degree in Naval Architecture from Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur, India

Started career, working as a Naval Architect with some private shipyards in Mumbai. Set up SHOFT in 1987, to manufacture Ship Outfit items. Soon diversified into turnkey contract building of ships at leading private and public sector shipyards on the west coast of India.

Established **Shoft Shipyard Pvt. Ltd., (SSPL)** at Bharuch, Gujarat, in 2005 with self owned land and infrastructure with head quarters in Mumbai. SHOFT has constructed and delivered more than 80 ships of various types and sizes for the commercial and Defense sector in India and overseas. Licensed to build warships, it builds auxiliary and support vessels for Indian Navy and Coast Guard.

With no fuss, after a few minutes of exchange of pleasantries, Mrs. & Mr.S.Radhakrishnan, handed over a cheque for Rs.5.5 Lakh to SES for a specified project in SIT, Trichy. It is worth mentioning few lines on this Munificence. Dr.M.Subbiah, MBBS, was probably the first doctor to set up a private clinic in Srirangam, in the year 1920. Mrs.Rukmani Ramanathan was his 2nd daughter. With the untimely demise of her beloved husband, Mr.Ramanathan, she became a widow in 1994, with no issues.
