In this quarter, few administrative changes were effected in SIT as per the guidance of the Management. Accordingly, Dr.V.G.Ravindhren took the charge as Principal, IC, Mrs.V.Vijayalakshmi as Vice Principal, Dr.K.Vijaykumar as HOD, IC of Paper Technology, Dr.G.Vairamani HOD IC Mechanical and Dr.Charles Franklin as Workshops-ic.

In order to enhance the admissions for the year 2024-25, SIT made advertisements in local TV Channels, All India Radio (FM-102.1), newspapers. Such things resulted in achieving 80% of the admissions against allotted seats of first year admissions. Further around 75 students were admitted in lateral entry i.e. second year admissions.

Management Team Visit

On 11th April 2024, Sri.V.K.Seshasayee, Chairman, SES and Sri.N.Gopalaratnam, Chairman, Seshasayee Papers and Boards Limited visited SIT for review of operations. They appreciated the faculty, staff for achieving the NBA accreditation for Mechanical, Paper Technology, Computer engineering and Instrumentation & Control Engineering. They had reviewed the operations, performance of the institution through a meeting with all HODs. Various factors have been analyzed to improve the admissions, starting new programs viz. Central Evaluation

On 29th April 2024, valuation of the autonomous examinations was held as per DOTE's rules and regulations. All examiners have submitted their evaluated and submitted the outcome of the autonomous examinations.

First and Second year Admissions:

On 6th May 2024, SIT started selling the applications for the first year and Second year (lateral entry).


RETIREMENT



AN HUMANATARIAN ACT OF OUR ALUMNUS



All readers of this issue must know the great humanitarian act of our alumnus Sri.T.K.Ramachandran, 1972, Mechanical, SIT in finding out Sri.N.Soundararajan, Lecturer (Physics) Retired; SIT who passed away on 04-05-2024.

Sri.N.Soundararajan was travelling with his son Sri.N.S.Rajagopal from Tiruchirapalli to Chennai on 25-04-2024. Next day early morning, at Tambaram, Sri Rajagopal found that his father was missing.

Sri.Rajagopal, with his friends, relatives searched at all railway stations between Trichy and Tambaram and filed FIR about Sri.NS missing.

Mrs.Lakshmi, one of Sri.NS's daughters posted a video clipping on 03-06-2024 in her what's app group, explaining that his father was missing since one month, requesting the viewer to inform any details of his father if known, may please be informed to her family members.

Sri.T.K.Ramachandran (TKR), 1972, Mechanical, SIT Alumnus, Senior Manager (Retired), BHEL Trichy saw the above video clipping and he made an appeal for locating Sri.NS through his several contacts through what's app messages. On 04-06-2024, Sri.TKR received a call from Mrs.Renuka, Thanjavur Merchants association informing that she found Sri.NS around a month back and confirmed that she arranged water, food to Sri.NS. Further she said that she could not get any details of Sri.NS, she helped Sri.NS in a safe location and went away. Once Sri.TKR heard this news from her, he at once informed the son of Sri.NS. On 03-06-2024, itself a team of people viz. Mrs.Renuka, Sri.TKR and family members of Sri.NS searched several places at Thanjavur. Finally they came to know that Sri.NS was admitted at "No attendant Ward" of Thanjavur Medical College Hospital on 03-05-2024 and passed away on 04-05-2024. All these things were known only on 04-06-2024. On 05-06-2024, family members of Sri.NS could collect the body, cremated at Thanjavur itself after due formalities of the Government.

Several alumni of SITAA, faculty of SIT have taken efforts in searching the whereabouts of Sri.NS during April, May till they located at Thanjavur Medical college. Above all, it is painful to note that Sri.TKR was with the distressed family members (three daughters and a son) throughout the week starting from 03-06-2024 till the cremation followed by rituals.

Though the family members were searching Sri.NS with distressed mind (they could not do anything or what, when, how, where to do....state of mind in highly distressed......), at that time, as an elderly person assisting the family members of Sri.NS, **Sri.TKR extended his full assistance both physically and mentally in fulfilling the formalities till cremation. When I had talk with Sri.TKR, he said that he did all these keeping in mind, Sri.NS in his father's position**. I conveyed my sincere thanks to him. From SIT side, our Dr.V.G.Ravindhren, Principal and Sri.R.Srinivasaraghavan met the family members at Thanjavur and conveyed the condolences. I conveyed my condolence to Smt. Lakshmi, Sri.N.S.Rajagopal.

SIT, SITAA salute Sri.T.K.Ramachandran, and all who assisted in solving a painful predicament.
